


**Conservation Opportunity Areas**

Species of greatest conservation need (SGCN): Does the area have known occurrences of SGCN?

Habitat: Does the area contain unique habitat communities or features important for conservation within the state? Does the area contain or have the potential for biological diversity?

Connectivity: Is the area part of a contiguous landscape, or is it heavily fragmented? Could it act as a stepping stone between other conservation areas?

Participation: Do partner organizations/agencies own the area? Are they willing and able to contribute to action within the area?

Capacity: Does funding and organizational ability exist to acquire and maintain the area for conservation?

Long-term Viability: Will the area be managed or maintained for conservation purposes in perpetuity?

Social/Public Support: Are the public willing to support maintenance and management of this area for conservation?
